**ORLANDO HEALTH LAW ATTORNEY WINS  
FAVORABLE DECISION AND DISMISSAL OF  
"IRREGULAR BEHAVIOR" CHARGES IN ECFMG CASE**



Orlando, Fla. - December 30, 2020 -The Health Law Firm announced that one of its attorneys, George F. Indest III, recently won a favorable decision from representation of an international medical graduate in a hearing held by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG).

The applicant, who attended a foreign medical school and was seeking to practice medicine in the U.S., was charged with "irregular behavior" by submitting an allegedly forged letter from his/her medical school dean to the ECFMG. Mr. Indest successfully obtained a finding of "No Irregular Behavior" after a hearing on December 2, 2020.
