ORLANDO ATTORNEY FEATURED IN NAPLES DAILY NEWS REGARDING DOCTOR POACHING LAWSUIT

Orlando, Fla. - September 8, 2018 - Attorney George F. Indest III, President and Managing Partner of The Health Law Firm, was recently quoted by a reporter for Naples Daily News concerning a legal dispute between two Florida hospitals. The lawsuit filed by Physicians Regional Healthcare System in June 2018, alleges that NCH Healthcare System was involved in doctor poaching.

Mr. Indest is extensively quoted regarding the central issue in this lawsuit, employment contracts that contain non-competition terms (also referred to as "restrictive covenants"). Non-competition terms in contracts are common with physician employees, especially with highly trained medical specialists, and Mr. Indest has been involved in a number of litigation cases over these.

"What's often in dispute is the length of time for the noncompete term. The courts pretty freely cut them back or rule that they are invalid and unenforceable for physicians and other healthcare professionals," Indest said.
