**ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS TO DISMISS INDICTMENT AS TO CERTAIN
DEFENDANTS (Docs. 147, 148)**

This matter is before the Court on the Government’s Unopposed Motion to Dismiss the Indictment without Prejudice and Stipulation (Doc. 147) and Motion to Dismiss Indictment as to Defendant Anthony Rattini (Doc. 148).


In the first motion, the Government moves to dismiss the Indictment against all remaining defendants, that is, Defendants Devonna Miller-West, Samuel R. Ballengee, and Miami-Luken Inc. That motion is unopposed. The parties agree to unconditionally release and hold harmless the United States Attorney’s Office for the Southern District of Ohio, Drug Enforcement Administration, their officers, employees and agents, and all other federal, state, and local enforcement agencies involved in the investigation and prosecution of this matter from any and all claims, demands, causes of actions or suits, of whatever kind and description, and wheresoever situated, that might now exist or hereafter exist by reason of or growing out of or affecting, directly or indirectly from this

investigation and prosecution.

Upon consideration, the Court **GRANTS** the unopposed motion and **DISMISSES** the Indictment against Defendants Miller-West, Ballengee, and Miami-Luken. The Court also **GRANTS** the motion as to Defendant Rattini and **DISMISSES** the Indictment against him.
