I am writing to inform you that the ECFMG Medical Education Credentials Committee (“Committee”) has completed its review of the allegation that you engaged in irregular behavior in connection with the submission to the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) of a fraudulent letter dated [REDACTED] purportedly issued by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Medical College, [REDACTED] which verifies the design of your final diploma. The Committee reviewed this matter at its [REDACTED] 2020 meeting.

In advance of the review, the members of the Committee were provided with the documents listed in ECFMG’s [REDACTED] 2020 letter and your response to the allegation submitted by your legal counsel, George F. Indest III, Esq., on [REDACTED] 2020. You made a personal appearance before the Committee accompanied by your legal counsel, George F. Indest III, Esq. A copy of the transcript of the proceedings will be sent to you as soon as it is available.

The Committee considered the documentation presented to it, including your oral testimony and Mr. Indest’s statements. Following careful review, the Committee determined that there was insufficient evidence to find you had engaged in irregular behavior in connection with this allegation.

You may now apply to ECFMG for USMLE examinations if you meet all the eligibility requirements for those examinations.
